# President's Message



## Preserving Affordability, Building the Future

Dear Friends,

This summer has brought with it significant milestones for RHF as we continue to grow with purpose and remain firmly committed to our mission of providing affordable housing and supportive services to those in need.

In May, we marked a special moment with a topping-off ceremony at Congregational Place in Chula Vista, California. This 55-unit affordable senior community is a vital step forward—not just in bricks and mortar, but in meeting the deep and growing need for housing that is both accessible and dignified. We anticipate completion in the first quarter of 2026, and I am eager to see the future residents move into a place they can call home.

Equally important is the progress we've made in preserving affordability across the country. This summer, RHF is acquiring five communities in Minnesota: Bethel Manor I, Bethel Manor II, Winona Shores in Alexandria, Park Villa in Park Rapids, and Parmly Lakeview on the Lake in Chisago City. Together, they represent 246 units of much-needed affordable housing. We held resident meetings to introduce RHF and answer questions, and we expect all acquisitions to be finalized by the end of the year.

These additions are not just growth—they are affordable housing preservation. In an environment where affordable housing is at risk of being lost to market-rate conversion, our ability to acquire, protect, and preserve these communities is core to who we are. Every acquisition is a promise to the residents that their homes will remain stable, affordable, and supportive.

Looking ahead, I remain hopeful about further acquisition opportunities that will allow us to deepen our impact. Our team is actively evaluating potential communities that align with our values and long-term strategy. I look forward to visiting some of our newly acquired properties in the coming months and connecting with residents and staff who embody RHF's mission every day.

Thank you for sharing this journey with us. With your support, we continue to create not just housing, but lasting stability and hope.

# Topping-Off Ceremony

## Congregational Place, Chula Vista, CA

On May 15 we reached a key milestone in the development of Congregational Place, our new affordable senior housing community in Chula Vista. Together with partners and community leaders, we celebrated the topping-off of the building—a tradition that marks the placement of the final structural beam and the project’s transition into its final phase of construction.

Located at the entrance to Chula Vista’s historic downtown, Congregational Place will offer 55 one-bedroom affordable apartments for low-income seniors, along with an on-site health care clinic to support aging in place. The development is a collaboration between RHF, Community Congregational Development Corporation (CCDC), San Ysidro Health, and the City of Chula Vista.

RHF’s Vice President of Acquisitions and Development, Bob Fard, opened the ceremony by recognizing the collective effort behind the project. “This milestone is not just about a building,” he said, “it’s about what we’re building for—community, dignity, and opportunity for older adults.”

Our President & CEO, Stuart Hartman, spoke about the urgent need for affordable senior housing in the region and how Congregational Place reflects RHF’s commitment to meeting that need. “We are proud to be part of the solution—bringing together housing and health care in a model that supports independence, affordability, and well-being.”

Following the ceremony, guests signed their names on the final steel beam before it was placed by Consolidated Contracting, our construction partner and event organizer. It was a meaningful moment, recognizing the many hands that have contributed to bringing this vision to life.

Congregational Place will feature fully accessible units, a PACE health clinic, and a wide range of amenities—from a community garden and yoga lawn to indoor gathering spaces and technology labs. Sustainability features, including solar panels, battery storage, and water-efficient systems, will help reduce costs and environmental impact.

With construction on track for completion in early 2026, we are proud of the progress made and grateful for the strong partnerships guiding this development forward. As Bob Fard shared in his closing remarks, “We’re one step closer to welcoming residents into a place they can truly call home—where they’ll find not only housing, but also care, connection, and community.”
